

Here are the answers to the questions raised at the meeting.

- 1.) Pony Club Shows – They run under their own rules and do not need to have permits. R rated Judges can officiate at these shows. There will be changes some time in the future.
- 2.) 4 H shows – They are treated the same as the Pony Club shows
- 3.) BC Summer Games – what level of shows qualifies for BC Summer Games – Bronze and up shows
Arbutus Winter Series shows where approved under the 2007 rules and can run under the old rules so all of the Summer Games points will count.
- 4.) Eventing and Dressage – I can not comment, Horse Council commented that they are still trying to answer and deal with all the issues. Need to check with them later.
- 5.) This question is about Summer Games and Cheryl Keith name is recorded but I do not understand.
- 6.) If you want to accumulate points for BC Summer Games where do you go and what type of show.
Bronze and up shows can hold BC Summer Games classes and Arbutus Jumpers can hold these classes. There will be other Bronze level shows on the island or in Vancouver. It depends on how far you want to travel. A list of the Shows holding classes are on the Website for Horse Council BC.
- 7.) Gifts – At this time there are no restrictions on gifts. They are treated differently than prize money.
- 8.) Life memberships with Equine Canada – these qualify for Gold level memberships, all officials with Equine Canada will need gold memberships.
